What is a Clay Shoot?

- Sporting Clays is the closest thing to actual field shooting of all shotgun sports. It is often described as "golf with a shotgun"
- It is a clay shooting event where participants will move from stand to stand, and shoot at clay disks as they are thrown into the air.
- Unlike trap and skeet, which are games of repeatable target presentations, sporting clays simulates the unpredictability of live-quarry shooting, offering a great variety of trajectories, angles, speeds, elevations, distances, and target sizes.
- You will shoot 100 clay targets as you move between the shooting stations.



What is the purpose of the event?

The Sporting Clay event has three main goals.

1. Raise money for Christian education in DeMotte
2. Help you sharpen your shooting skills prior to the start of hunting season
3. Have fun with people who love DeMotte Christian Schools and love to shoot

About the DMC Foundation

- The DeMotte Christian School Foundation Fund was established in 1982.
- Between its inception and the 2014-2015 school year, the Foundation Fund has distributed over \$1,400,000 to the DeMotte Christian General Fund and has grown to its current value of more than \$1,900,000.
- The Foundation Fund most currently contributes over \$95,000 annually to the General Operating Fund of DeMotte Christian School. This equates to tuition reduction of over \$400 per family.
- The Foundation Fund Golf Outing raises approximately \$40,000 each year for the Fund. This has been the single largest fundraiser for the Foundation Fund. The Foundation Board thanks the members of the Golf Committee and all those who contribute to each year's outing.
- Several years ago, the Foundation Fund built a Foundation House (using donated and reduced cost materials and labor). The Foundation Board thanks the area contractors and builders who made this possible. Proceeds from the sale of the home were added to the Foundation Fund.
- This Shooting Sports Fundraiser is another creative endeavor of the Foundation Board. We continue to seek innovative ways to strengthen the Christian Education movement here in DeMotte and to make quality Christian Education available to more students.
- The Foundation Board of Trustees utilizes the services and advice of Jack Sytsma and Dave Van Wingerden, who are with the Grand Rapids office of Morgan Stanley.

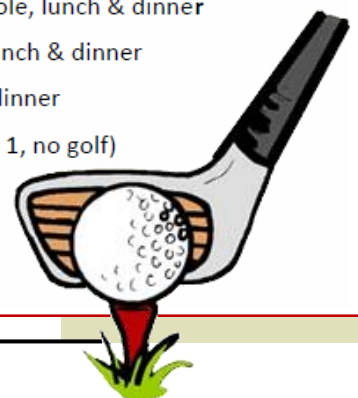

Did you know that Indiana has its own Poet Laureate? Shari Wagner, appointed by the Indiana Arts Commission, is Indiana's Poet Laureate for 2016 and 2017, and she will be visiting our DeMotte Library at 11:00 on Saturday, September 10.

Wagner grew up in rural Wells County and has since traveled extensively, taking part in cross-cultural exchanges in Somalia, Kenya, Haiti and the Honduras as well as domestic cross-cultural experiences living with Native Americans in Louisiana. Her special areas of interest are Indiana history and Native American history, with a particular passion for folklore and regional stories.

"I am delighted and honored to represent poetry in the state that has shaped my artistic vision in so many ways and given me such a wealth of subjects to explore," Wagner said. In these 2 years as our Poet Laureate Wagner hopes to travel the entire state promoting Indiana poets and fostering the writing and reading of poems in a variety of settings, including libraries, schools, parks, senior and veteran centers and Indiana's many historic sites. Wagner noted that she is excited that Indiana's bicentennial and the centennial of its state parks occur during her term, and she celebrates these important anniversaries by emphasizing poetry's role in our history and natural settings.

Debbie Kristoff, library branch manager, stated "DeMotte Library has offered various programs to mark Indiana's Bicentennial and we now invite all residents and families to come and enjoy this very special program." Also worth noting, Indiana's Poet Laureate visits our library at a most significant time as we mark its 50th anniversary in our community.
