

#### NEED A HEALTHCARE PROGRAM THAT WORKS?



A component of the state's Healthy Indiana Plan, the HIP Employer Link Program gives businesses an opportunity to attract and retain a productive workforce by helping employees that qualify have a portion of their employer group health insurance premium costs paid. The goal of the



initiative is healthier employees – which are happier and more productive with fewer absences and longer periods of sustained employment with their employer. Here's how the program works: The employer registers and receives HIP Employer Link approval. They then deduct from their eligible employees' pay the cost or premium charged to each employee for the applicable group health insurance. The state of Indiana then directly reimburses each employee on a monthly basis the amount of the deduction less a small employee contribution. There is no cost to the business for participating in the program. Raw gypsum is obtained as a byproduct from the adjacent coal-fired electric power generating station
