



#### Can everybody upgrade and what does it cost?

Most modern computers can accept Solid State Drives out of the box. Some computers require additional adapters or hardware, but that can be discussed further on an individual basis.

The cost is determined by how much storage you require. 95% of folks never even come close to filling up their hard drives, so we try to be conservative when it comes to purchasing an SSD, as the amount of storage is not quite up to where traditional hard drive storage sizes are currently.

### \*As of June 1, 2018, a 256GB SSD drive is about the cost of a 1TB traditional drive.\*

In other words, 1/4 the storage space for a 16X improvement in speed. Again, for most people, choosing to sacrifice some space for a dramatic improvement in performance is a no-brainer when they couldn't possibly fill the space they had originally. For a 256GB SSD, cloning and installation into a laptop is only \$150 + tax, or \$125 + tax for a desktop.






