Meet Your Teacher Open House








Over the course of the last few months, as Belstra Milling Co. and the farms have continued to grow in people, tons, pigs, trucks, customers and recognition, we began the discussion around how we position ourselves for the future. Belstra is proud to announce that we have updated our brand and moved our administration team into our new offices.

For 64 years we have honored the tradition of Bud and Flo Belstra by wearing the BMC logo proudly on all of our clothing, and this is something I hope we never forget. However, as we move towards the future and continue to work as a team with the same goals and values, it was time to update our brand. The first change we implemented was to consolidate our brand into one company. Belstra Milling Co. is made up of three key divisions; Belstra Milling, Belstra Group Farms, and BMC Transport. What we found out during the process was, though we have three key divisions, the general public just recognizes us as Belstra. So we started with simplifying our name.



The second change was incorporating our original logo, which included three parts; colors, heritage, and divisions. Thus, the three petal tulip was created.





The tulip represents the Dutch heritage of the Belstra family. The three petals represent the three divisions of Belstra (feed, pigs, transport). The colors represent the original colors picked out by Bud and Flo, and the green represents the combination of and collaboration of all three divisions as one group. We are excited to unveil our new logo as we think it will continue to help us grow into the future while still looking back on what brought us to where we are today.

In addition to the new logo, Belstra has also renovated the old Kaper's Building Materials store and relocated our management and administration into the new office at 308 15th St. SE. For those still looking to buy feed and farm supplies, our store has not moved and is still located in front of the feed mill.

We are excited for the continued growth and hope these changes set us up for the future.

Jasper County Airport-Tunes on the Tarmac 2018

Jasper County Airport hosted a second Tunes on the Tarmac charity benefit concert this last April. The concert series is intended to help fund charities and causes with local reach. April's concert raised \$640 which will go toward funding a Jasper County Sheriff's Department project. The project aims to reunite lost/missing children with their families by issuing ID cards to parents that can be given to emergency personnel immediately after a child goes missing. The equipment will be stored in a trailer and is intended to be deployed at large events and gatherings. The IDs will be issued free of charge. The project was the brainchild of the 2017-2018 Purdue Extension Leadership Class, in partnership with Jasper Foundation, Jasper County, JC Sheriff's Department, and the Jasper Foundation. The approximately 75 in attendance were treated to a live family-friendly performance by 2 great regional bands who departed their performance to




Food concessions were sold by the Lions Club.
