





The DeMotte Chamber is hosting a month-long shopping extravaganza this Holiday season. It begins on Small Business Saturday, November 24. American Express began the coast-to-coast campaign in 2011 to help promote small businesses. The DeMotte Chamber has proudly been a Small Business Saturday Neighborhood Champion since 2014, raising shopping awareness in DeMotte.

Last year, the Shop DeMotte & Win campaign processed over \$60,000 in receipts in the four week long event. "We were so excited with how well the event went." commented Diva Rish, Chamber executive director.
