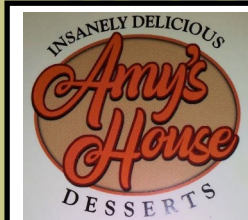

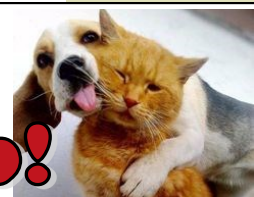

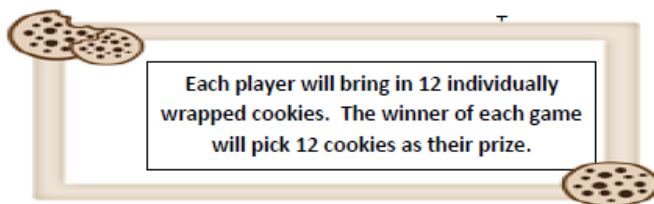

Position Responsibilities:

The Jasper County Economic Development Organization is seeking an Economic Development Coordinator. This candidate will report to the Executive Director but will assist all staff in research and other economic development activities.

The Economic Development Coordinator manages and supports day-to-day administration of a variety of programs including grants and Economic Development research efforts. Works closely with and supports Economic Development leadership to manage innovative programs to improve economic development and business resources and opportunities throughout the County.

Summary of essential job functions:

- Assists in research efforts, including qualitative and quantitative research projects, using online software to distribute surveys and analyze data. Research efforts could include, but are not limited to:
 - County industry and company information
 - Incentive performance analysis
 - Demographic analysis
- Participates in developing and implementing trainings and other resources for local businesses and organizations
- Assists in writing research briefs, white papers, and articles and presents findings at public events.
- Assists on RFI/RFP including project specific research, incentive analysis, building/site identification, and project submittal
- Develops and maintains content for website and social media.
- Develop economic development specific marketing material to be distributed to both internal and external stakeholders.
- Supports grant initiatives including researching grant opportunities, drafting Requests for Proposals and assist in scoring; generating quarterly reports; marketing grant programs; and coordinating with contractors, funding agencies, state agencies, and other stakeholders to ensure compliance with funding requirements.
