



NIPSCO Seeks Grant Applications for Public Safety Education and Responder Training

A detailed project description, including the amount requested, scope of the project and community impact. An overview of how support will be recognized (press release, social media, website, etc.) and how it will benefit your organization.

Attach project budget, a list of the board of directors and other project contributors.




