#### Board Member Outreach for Junior Achievement Serving Kankakee Valley:

We are asking for community members that are dedicated to students in your area and to support the education for students and support local teachers in their educational curriculums.

The mission of Junior Achievement is to inspire and prepare young people to succeed in a global economy. Junior Achievement empowers young people to own their future economic success by enhancing the relevancy of education. At every grade level JA program's expose student's to basic business concepts and the skills that enable them to understand real-life economics. With this knowledge, they build an understanding regarding economic choices and the resulting consequences of each decision. This prepares them for economically independent futures based on strong economic knowledge and solid personal financial management skills.

The Commitment time for volunteers is 2-3 hours per month and meetings are in person at the Sandie Pines Bridal house or you may choose to Zoom in for convivence.

Members of the Junior Achievement Board are an integral part of furthering the aims of the organization through their work and other leading business people, educators, and community representatives. The Board's role is to provide and generate resources for local JA programs. The responsibility of setting and monitoring the strategic direction of its area is held by the Board of Directors.

Members of the Board are elected by the majority of the current Board of Directors. The board member term for officers is 3 years. Board member terms are annual, with the option to renew each year. Our 2021-2022 budget for programs is \$19,000 and we also have reserved funds for special programs called JA Finance Park and a field trip opportunity to Lafayette BizTown or any other program our local educators request.

#### Expectations

- Support Junior Achievements mission, purpose, goals, policies, and programs, while knowing its strengths and needs.
- Serve actively on at least one event committee and participate in 60% of the committee meetings.
- 3. Provide leadership and support in fundraising needs.
- Donate an annual financial gift according to personal means to show our grantors our board has 100% board participation.
- Assist Junior Achievement by teaching a minimum of 1 JA class a school year and/or assist with the recruitment of volunteers.
- Participate actively in at least one event by attending, sponsoring, soliciting sponsors and/or recruit volunteers sponsored by Junior Achievement.
- Attend at least 80% of the board meetings. Anyone who fails to attend 2 consecutive meetings, without notification, may be subject for removal.
- Suggest nominees to the board that reflect the diversity in our community. Specifically, men and women who can make significant contributions to the work and the progress of Junior Achievement.
- Sign a Conflict of Interest Statement and Confidentiality Policy, annually, to disclose conflicts & agree to abide by all Junior Achievement bylaws when representing organization.
- Prepare for and participate in board and committee meetings.
- 11. Support the majority decision on issues decided by the board.
- Maintain confidentiality of the board's executive sessions, and speak for the board only when authorized.
- Suggest agenda items for board and committee meetings to ensure that significant policy related matters are addressed.
- Read and understand the financial statements and help the board fulfill its fiduciary and operating responsibilities.
- 15. Provide input and feedback on the performance of the Executive Director.

We're open Saturday mornings until 12 noon and as always, same day appointments are available. Call 219-987-7750.






