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WHAT IS A Business Mixer?

A Business Mixer is a morning or evening open-house-style social gathering of business peers. It is designed to bring businesses together and share what business, product or service they provide. This event doesn't require an agenda, such as speakers on topics, it is to gain new business relationships and contacts for you and other businesses. This event is open to all businesses, not just Chamber members; however in order to host a Business Mixer, you must be a current Chamber Member in good standing (dues paid).

You choose a Morning or Evening Mixer during the 3rd full week of the month

Morning: 7-8:30am

Evening: 5-6:30pm

- Be available to assist you with questions or event suggestions at any time

WHAT ARE THE HOSTING BUSINESS RESPONSIBILITIES?

Your business is the host of this event. Make it yours!

The Chamber is here to help you. However, we strongly encourage you to take some of the following suggestions into consideration. Conducting your own PR campaigns to increase awareness is highly suggested. Please note, you should not rely solely on the Chamber for your audience or event festivities.

- Designate a contact person
- If you have designed a promotional flyer, send it to the Chamber electronically
- Finalize details prior to promoting the event, ensure that you and the Chamber are on the same page
- Run promos on your social media. Co-promoting this event is helpful for success.
- Send email & paper invitations to your vendor contact list
- Invite employees, friends, family, and contractors
- Order banners and signage, if you choose
- Consider offering branded giveaway items or having door prizes or special drawing(s)
- Consider giving guided tours, product demos, etc., if applicable
- Food and beverages add a nice touch! Breakfast items for morning mixers, and snacks or hors d'oeuvres are perfectly acceptable. Offer as much or as little as you like, and yes, evening adult beverages are acceptable as well
- Send a post-event press release and post to your social media platforms showing what a great time everyone had!





Frequently Asked Questions

Planning a Business Mixer can be stressful. You may have many questions or not know where to start. Luckily, since this is your event, there are no set rules! Here are a few FAQ that may help.

Q: When should I begin talking to the Chamber about my event?

A: Begin the conversation no less than 2-3 weeks prior to the Mixer. This allows the Chamber to confirm the date, add it to the calendar, and share it with members and social media.

Q: When is the best time to have a Business Mixer?

A: Choose a day that works best for your staff. Any weekday is appropriate.

Q: Do I have to have the event during the recommended hours?

A: No, if another time works best for you and your staff, pre-arrange that with Diva and it will be promoted as such.

Q: How many guests can we expect?

A: The Chamber cannot guarantee the number of attendees. Multiple factors play into how many guests will attend. You are welcome to require an RSVP if you so choose, but we do not require RSVPs for this event.

Q: Should we offer door prizes, drawings or giveaways?

A: It's a good idea to have door prizes or swag for your guests. Attending
